**Meeting Minutes**

**I. Committee members reviewed the goals of the committee as set at the LPC retreat.**

**The committee rewrote the goals as follows:**

- I. Develop Special Needs training for child care providers. Advocate for future funding for Special Needs trainings.
- II. Advocate for improved Health and Safety (including Food and Nutrition) practices among child care programs.
- III. Advocate for increased access to developmentally appropriate Infant/Toddler care.

Committee members decided to merge the Special Needs Committee into the Comprehensive Quality Care committee and to create a new committee to focus on After-school Care with the main goal of advocating for increased access to quality (DAP/CAP) after care programming.

**II. Committee members wrote the following draft Mission Statement for the CQC committee:**

It is the mission of the Comprehensive Quality Care Committee to advocate for improved quality of child care in the areas of: Health and Safety, Special Needs and Infant/Toddler Care.
