

Final Weekly child care legislation update for 2006

Summary of Bills

Final weekly child care legislation update of the legislative year attached. New session begins December 4, 2006. Next update after the first relevant bills are introduced. I will send it to everyone on the current list unless someone asks to be taken off.

By accident, I just discovered [AB 1808](#) yesterday, which was passed and signed in July. It eliminated the 75% rule in APP programs and does many other things in its 107 pages. If anybody knows about a bill relevant to child care or child development that I am not tracking next year, I would appreciate hearing about it so I can include it.
