I. CCECE Conference

- In collaboration with CCPC, ECE Conference committee hosted the CCECE Conference on Saturday, October 1st. The conference was attended by more than 260 early care and education professionals. Opening session included a presentation by Sheri Hunt, Co-Director of Google Children's Centers, followed by the presentation of Voice and Vision, and Early Educator of the Year awards.
